In 2013, the Government of Lesotho sought financial assistance from the African Development Bank (AfDB) to finance a four-year eGovernment Infrastructure project. The objective of the project was to enhance good governance of the country by deploying a modern and secure e-government broadband infrastructure. The Project is also expected to strengthen the existing Government data centers and portals; and improve access to e-services for state building such as automated administrative services including e-payroll; civil registrar; e-health, e-procurement, e-customs and revenue management. The Project is currently in closure phase.

The project is now in its second phase whose objectives are to improve rural connectivity, expansion of broadband infrastructure to critical parts of the country, and the establishment of a national Payment System. Specifically, the project shall:
