From 21:00pm to 05:00am













- 30% capacity of the church inside only.
- The service should last for not more than two hours.
- Facemasks covering nose and mouth must be worn through out the service including when singing.
- Allow one hour disinfection between services.









LIQUOR STORES (wholesalers, offsales, tarvens, shebeens canteens) and Nightclubs



- Liquor stores operate from Monday to Friday.
- Open from 08:00am to 06:00pm with take-out only.
- Nightclubs to be completely closed









FUNERALS



- All provisions of the funeral remain with the following addition:
- Nuclear family members are allowed to identify, view and collect the corpse during the morning of the burial day at the mortuary.











CULTURAL AND CREATIVE INDUSTRIES



Restricted BUT allowed for promotion and sale of art.











Permitted and open from 08:00am to 06:00pm









PUBLIC TRANSPORT



- 4+1: 3 passengers not counting the driver.
- 15 Seater: 11 passengers not counting the driver and his deputy.
- 22 Seater: 15 passengers not counting the driver and his deputy
- Bus: Occupy one seat on a two-seater bench, and occupy two seats on a three-seater bench, occupy only four seats on the backbench







GAMBLING INDUSTRY



- Casino: the number of persons entering a casino shall not exceed 50%, based on the available floor space of the casino.
- Sport betting: the number of persons entering a sports betting site shall be determined by 1.5-meter social distancing. Television screening is not allowed.
- Operate at 50% capacity of LPM space.
 Allow only independent site operators not sharing space with liquor and restaurant business.







ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES 100% RESTRICTED

- Initiation\Traditional Schools
- Social/ Family Gatherings
- Political Gatherings
- Public Recreational Areas (parks)
- Industrial Action (picketing, protests, demonstrations)









ANY OTHER BUSINESSES, PUBLIC, PRIVATE AND NGO INSTITUTIONS



- Permitted with 50% capacity of staff with rotation.
- Operate from 08:00am to 04:00pm









INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL



- Movements across borders should include:
- Essential goods and services.
- Business people including hawkers with permits and truck drivers.
- Diplomats.
- Medical reasons (with permits)
- Migrant Workers
- Pensioners to collect their monthly pension in RSA.
- Students including student commuters.
- Commuting teachers.
- Funerals for parents, children, siblings and grandparents only.
- People with special needs and who shall be approved by the Minister of Health







ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY



- Not permitted for events and performances.
- Only allowed to sell their music and products on the streets.









WEDDINGS



- Allow only 50 people.
- Wedding to last for two hours only.
- No alcohol, no buffet service, only pre-packed meals.









SPORTS EVENTS



Non contact sports permitted with no spectators while observing COVID-19 protocols.







TOURISM INDUSTRY



- Accommodation venues open with 100% occupancy.
- Allow conferences, meetings, and workshops at 50% capacity of the conference facility.









RESTAURANTS & FAST FOODS



Operate with 50% capacity for sit-ins from 06:00am to 08:00pm.









SCHOOLS AND INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING



- Open on rotational basis.
- All must adhere to Standard Risk-Based Guidelines
- School bus drivers must operate at 50% capacity, disinfect daily, sanitise the students and ensure that students wear facemasks at all times







GYMS



Open for not more than 50 people outside while observing COVID-19 Protocols.













To operate on appointment only from 08:00am to 06:00pm.







PITSO



- Maximum of 50 people outside for COVID-19 awareness only.
- Food and alcohol not allowed.
- Should last not more than 2 hours.
